Twice she was removed for questioning and a fellow prisoner, Miss F.W.Lee, now of Christchurch in New Zealand, has supplied a list of the charges made against her and of her answers to them. Here is the list:

1. That she had worked amongst the Jews.
2. That she had wept when putting yellow stars on the girls.
3. That she had dismissed her housekeeper, who was an Aryan.
4. That she had listened to the news broadcasts of the B.B.C.
5. That she had many British visitors.
6. That she was active in politics.
7. That she visited British prisoners of war.
8. That she sent them parcels.

Those are the „crimes“ then and these are the answers she gave.

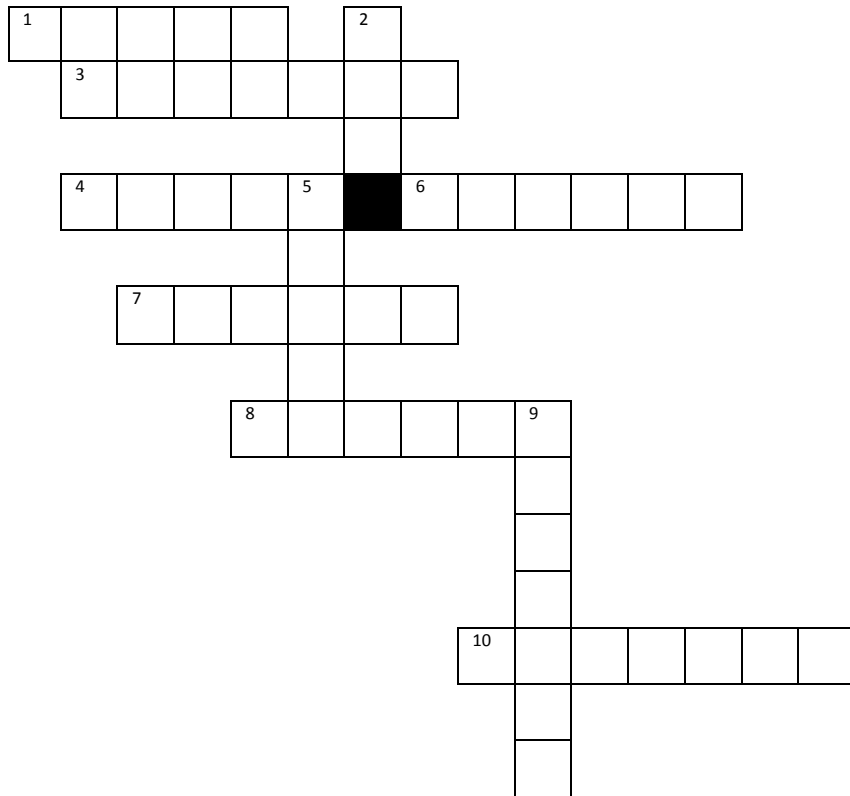
It was true that she worked among Jews. That was her chosen work. It was true that she had wept when she had to send the girls from the Home to the school with the yellow star on their dresses. Yes, she had wept and at the thought of it she began to weep again. The German officer was evidently affected by this, for he very considerately retired till she had regained her self-control. It was true that she had dismissed her Aryan housekeeper. The law compelled her to do that, for the law laid down that an Aryan could not be employed in a house where Jews lived. As to having a radio, that also was true. She had to have one, for she had children under her charge and it was necessary that she should hear the warnings about air raids. It was natural that she should have British visitors, for she herself was British. But she did deny, with all the force that was in her, that she had talked politics or meddled in politics. This charge she totally denied. It was true that she had visited British prisoners of war and sent them parcels. For both of these things, express permission had been granted her by the Hungarian Government.
